Voted Awards:

Rookie of the Year

The rookie who steps up his/her play and commitment to the team and delivers an impact on the field. One award is made annually to a player from the men's and the ladies' teams.

Most Improved Player

The player who demonstrates, over the course of the year, the greatest level of improvement and commitment to the team on the field. One award is made annually to a player from the men's and the ladies' teams.

Most Valuable Player

The player who demonstrates the best combination of talent, skill, commitment, and leadership to the team on the field. One award is made annually to a player from the men's and the ladies' teams.

PigDog of the Year ('The Rick Kitchin Award')

The person who demonstrates the most commitment and dedication to the club on and off the field.

Chosen Awards:

Molson Award (aka Supporter of the year)

The Club President presents this award to the person who supported PigDog rugby throughout the year which includes both on and off the field – from matches, club events, participating in Rugby NS initiatives, and generally representing the PigDog spirit.

Coaches Award

Coaching staff of each team will present the Coaches Award to the player they feel demonstrated the true spirit of PigDog rugby through their play, attitude, effort, sportsmanship, and commitment to the team. This award was created in the 2014 season.

Junior LPD Award

Selected by the coaching staff of the junior sevens team, given to the player who demonstrated the best combination of talent, skill, commitment, and leadership to the team during the junior seven's games.
